

Anatomy 4D Posters

Not all schools are lucky enough to be able to afford the 3D body models and even if they are, sometimes body parts get lost over time. Why not take a look at this great app which allows the children to see different parts of the body as if they were right there in front of them. This tool can be used for secondary research in topics such as skeletons, the digestive system and the circulatory system.

First ask the children to draw what they think the skeleton looks like or the digestive system or heart as a pre-assessment. Then download the app and print out the poster. Ask the children to then hold their tablet or iPad over the image. Get ready for their reaction as they see different parts of the body come alive. Can they use this information to create a new detailed model or drawing?

Or why not play a team memory game where the children have a minute to look at the image and then run back to their group and sketch what they can remember from the image. Repeat until all the children have added to their groups image. Then compare each group to see what's missing.
